




The Solution

The solution was the installation of a **JIMCO** air purification system,

which uses photolytic oxidation to break down odour-causing compounds.







This technology converts the compounds into harmless by products such as water vapor and carbon dioxide – without the use of chemicals.

The system was quickly put into operation and was able to efficiently treat the large volume of air generated by the production process.
